We had all locked down, but in spite of this Covid -19 situations, Sannihita Girls Home pulled up its sleeves to take the issue forward. We tried to make the survival happen. We believed that we have the Strength & courage to provide care to the home children and as well as to the parents, guardians and to our children, who were repatriated at that time.

Due to the covid-19 situation prevailing in the society some of our residential team have gone to live with their families. We had to send few children to their parents, guardians up to May 2020.

The children were attending classes run by the senior students and by our residential team. Online classes through teachers some children's through zoom app and Google meetings started happening from July onwards.

Due to pandamic situation, the home residential teacher have taken regular classes, made the children practice critical words and sentences on the board without confusion. We made sure that they repeat the sentenses so that they can pronounce well. They identify the children who are slow learners and take special care by teaching them with audio visual material made by our team and on line educational material.

HOME SANITIZATION:







Usha madam has instructed that the home should be sanitized for 3 times a month, every 10minites to sanitize the hands and to see that everyone wears the mask.



Nutrition food care is the main aspect in the home towards children; home team will follow the menu as decided by the food committee and home management team as per the instruction and food policy. 


