


We train the never end rolled children and drop out children by Bridge course and then admit them in the school according to their age group in the perspective classes

Home Sanitization




Usha madam has instructed that the home should be Sanitized for 3 times a month, every 10minites to sanitize the hands and to see that everyone wears the mask.



She has cautioned them to be very careful in their diet plans which should include nutritious food and warm water with ginger soup daily to combat COVID.
